

REMOTE & HYBRID WORKING

Working well together as a team is now even more important!

- Managers need to put more effort into creating team cohesion.
- Successful employees need very good communication skills, more proactivity, and need to make more effort to connect with people.

What does it mean for a researcher?

- Remote user research: skills and effort needed to create a connection with the user and extract insights.
- More effort to communicate insights.
- Design discussions and workshops need to be more planned.

A researcher might be switching between doing remote user interviews at home and team workshops in the office.

SCOPE OF WORK & RESPONSIBILITY EXPANDING

- More involved in development process and working more closely with other functions.
- More cross functional teams.
- Less agency work, more in-house jobs, because more integrated working.

- Researcher more involved in design activities (design sprints), creating journey maps, using more quant data and working with data analysts.
- User research will become more important for company strategy and will be more represented in top management - when UX maturity of the company is rising.
